Tips to Keep Your Pets Safe This Summer

Our pets love summer just as much as we do! For many, it's the best time of year to be out, about, and enjoying all that the season has to offer. Remember these important tips to keep your pets safe this summer:

1. Never, ever, EVER leave your dog in a hot car On a day at 78 degrees it can take minutes – yes, MINUTES – for a pet to develop heat stroke and suffocate in a car.

2. Make sure your dog is protected from parasites like fleas, ticks, and mosquitoes If not protected, your dog is at risk for heartworm, Lyme disease, Rocky Mountain spotted fever, and a host of other nasty and dangerous conditions.

3. Keep your dog's paws cool When the sun is cooking, surfaces like asphalt or metal can get really hot! Try to keep your pet off of hot asphalt; not only can it burn paws, but it can also increase body temperature and lead to overheating.

4. Dogs get sunburns too! Believe it or not, dogs can sunburn, especially those with short or light-colored coats. Talk to your vet about sunscreen for your pet.

5. Don't assume your dog can swim well Just because dogs instinctively know how to swim, doesn't mean they're good swimmers. And if your dog jumps in your swimming pool, he might not be able to get out without help and could easily drown. Make sure your dog can't get into your swimming pool without you around.
